

ACCOMPANIMENTS

Volunteers provide accompaniment when requested by a crisis caller or client of the centre to support survivors who need access to community services like the hospital, police station, court, lawyer's office or any other agency.

Responsibilities

- To be present with the client at the specified appointment
- To provide support and to take direction from the client with respect to any advocacy that is to be offered.

Requirements

- Must have successfully completed the Crisis and Support Line Volunteer Training
- Act within the spirit of SACL's Vision/Mission/Principles.
- Adhere to SACL's policies and procedures.
- Maintain confidentiality as outlined in SACL's Confidentiality Policy.

Training
