The Public Education & Outreach program provides workshops and trainings which examine the spectrum of sexual violence and works to create tolerance and motivation for change in our communities by modeling conscious language, creating safe space and encouraging respectful dialogue. These presentations not only provide information on Sexual Violence but also open up a discourse and develop a lens for students to examine the intersectionalities of gender, race, class and sexual orientation that shape the culture of violence in which we currently live.

SACL Public Education Facilitators are available for presentations, displays and other violence prevention initiatives at your school/agency upon request. Presentations can be delivered any day of the week, with at least 2 weeks notice.

SACL Public Education Facilitators will design a workshop or presentation to meet your group's needs. Some of the topics can include:

- *Date Rape/Sexual Assault*
- *Rape Culture: The Continuum of Sexual Violence*
- *Sexual Harassment*
- *Childhood Sexual Abuse*
- *Healthy Relationships*
- *Examining Gender and its Impact on Violence*
- *Sexual Violence: Myths and Realities*
- *Culture Jamming: Dissecting mainstream media's influence on our bodies, sexuality, gender and relationships.*
- *Seen and Heard: Against the backlash of girl bashing (Internalized Misogyny)*
- *Violence against the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transsexual community and its representation in the Media*
- *Disclosure Training (How to Respond Sensitively and Respectfully to Sexual Violence Disclosures)*

The majority of our workshops are free, we simply request an honorarium to be given where possible. These funds will support SAACL services, such as the Counseling Program, the Public Education Program, Community Events, and the Volunteer Program.
